

How To Download and Open Files Statcato

Step 1: Download Java

For Windows

- Go to <https://ninite.com> (Avoid using browser. Type in website address)
- Click on “Java 8”
- Click the button “Get your Ninite”.

For MAC

- Go to <https://java.com/en/download> (Avoid using browser. Type in website address)
- Click the button “Free Java Download” (decline antivirus and toolbar requests)

Step 2: Download Statcato

For Windows

- Go to www.statcato.org/statcato/index.php (Avoid using browser. Type in website address)
- Click on the button that says “Downloading the Latest Version from SourceForge now”
- A window with the “statcato_complete_1.0.2.zip” will open. Push “OK”
- Drag or copy and paste the folder that says “statcato complete” onto your desktop. You cannot open Statcato from the zip file. The zip file must be saved to your computer first.
- Open the “statcato_complete” file on your desktop and click on “Statcato.jar”. (This will open the Statcato program)
- To create a shortcut on your desktop. Right click on “Statcato.jar”, click “send to”, then “desktop (create shortcut)”. If you cannot create a shortcut, you can still open the program by going to the “statcato_complete” file on your desktop and clicking on “Statcato.jar”.

For MAC

- Go to www.statcato.org/statcato/index.php (Avoid using browser. Type in website address)
- Click on the button that says “Downloading the Latest Version from SourceForge now”
- A window with the “statcato_complete_1.0.2.zip” will open. Push “OK”
- Open on the zip folder that says “_MACOSX”. You will see a folder inside it that says “statcato_complete”. This is the MAC version of the statcato zip file.
- Drag or copy and paste the folder that says “statcato complete” onto your desktop. You cannot open Statcato from the zip file. The zip file must be saved to your computer first.
- Open the “statcato_complete” file on your desktop and click on “Statcato.jar”. (This will open the Statcato program)
- To create a shortcut on your desktop. Right click on “Statcato.jar”, click “send to”, then “desktop (create shortcut)”. If you cannot create a shortcut, you can still open the program by going to the “statcato_complete” file on your desktop and clicking on “Statcato.jar”.
- Your MAC computer may block opening Statcato. You may need to go to your “System Preferences” section, click on “Security and Privacy”, then click “Allow Apps Downloaded”.

Step 3: Opening Data Files in Statcato

For Windows

- Windows computers usually work well with copy and pasting data from Excel data files. However if you wish to open an entire data file in Statcato, you will need to use data that has been saved in Statcato (Statcato data file “.stc”). First, save the Statcato Data file on your computer. Then go to the “File” menu and click on “Open Project”. Then find the Statcato file on your computer and push “Open”.

For MAC

- Some MAC computers may have issues copying and pasting. If that is the case you can open the excel file in Statcato instead of copy and pasting. First save the Excel data file on your computer. Open Statcato, then go to the “File” menu and then “Open Data Sheet”. Find your Excel data file and then click “Open”. Note: Data files saved in Statcato (“.stc”) may have problems on the MAC. Some MAC users report problems making graphs if they open a Statcato file with “Open Projects”. It is better to open the Excel data file with “Open Data Sheet”.
