Week 4 (Sept 14th – Sept 20th)

Welcome to Math 090/140 week 4. Hopefully you have submitted all of your week 3 assignments. It is exam time! In week 4, you will be watching review videos, working on review problems and studying for your exam. At the end of the week, you will be taking your first exam on chapter 1. You will also be completing your third Math 090 Canvas Quiz in your Math 090 Canvas site section#51115. There are no assignments due this week. You only have to take the Quiz#3 and the Chapter 1 Exam.

Math 090 Quiz#3 (Due by September 20, 2020)

- Math 090 Quiz#3: Many students struggle with sections 1F and 1G on the exam. Math 090 topic#3 is to practice problems from sections 1F and 1G so you are better prepared for the exam. Of course, you still have to study sections 1A – 1E as well to really be ready for the exam.
- **Directions:** Go to your Math 090 Canvas section#51115. Click on the “Pages” menu. Then click on “View all Pages” on the top left. Now click on Topic#3 quantitative data analysis. Read the notes and section assigned. Watch the videos and take notes. When you are ready, click on the “Quizzes” menu and take the “Math 090 Quiz#3”. You are encouraged to take the quiz over and over until you get 100%. Each time you take the quiz, you will get different problems. You can take the quiz as many times as you wish. Your highest score will count toward your grade in Math 090.

Study for the Chapter 1 Exam (September 14, 2020 – September 19, 2020)

- Go to your Math 140 Canvas section#51205 and click on the “Modules” menu. Then click on “Chapter 1 Review”. This has study guides and a four part review lecture to get you ready for the exam. It discusses the exam details and highlights what to study. There are review problems in the review sheet with the answers. These are good to practice, but will not be turned in.

Take Exam Chapter 1 (September 19, 2020 or September 20, 2020)

- Directions: Go to your Math 140 Canvas Section#51205 and click on the “Quizzes” menu. Then click on “Teachout Exam Chapter 1”. **The exam may be taken either Saturday 9/19 or Sunday 9/20, but must be completed by Midnight (Los Angeles Time) on Sunday 9/20.**

Information about Exam Chapter 1

- The Exam is based on material from Sections 1A - 1G.
- There are 50 total questions. Each question is worth 1 point. The questions are multiple choice, true/false, or short answer.
- It is timed at 75 minutes. For students that have sent a DSPS accommodations letter to Mr. Teachout, you have been given more time.
- You must complete the test in **one-sitting**.
- You only get **ONE attempt**.
- **Do not use notes or the textbook during the exam!** You do not have time to look up answers on your computer or other device while taking the exam. Study for the exam and watch the exam review video before taking the exam. **Answer the questions as if you were sitting in class without notes or the textbook.**
- **Do NOT stop the exam or click away from Canvas once the exam is started.** Canvas keeps track of the number of times you interrupt the exam. **If I see that you have been stopping the exam to look up answers on your computer or other device, I will consider it cheating and will NOT count the exam score.**
- Be careful when scrolling up & down the page as it could change your selected answers.
- Verify your answers before you submit the Exam.
