

## **Statcato Directions** (Updated January 2019)

If Statcato is installed on the computer: *Statcato is installed in all computers in the classroom and in TLC so feel free to use those computers to analyze data. If Statcato is installed, there will be an icon on the desktop. Just click the icon to open Statcato.*

If Statcato is NOT installed on the computer: *If you are on a laptop or computer where Statcato is NOT installed, go to [www.statcato.org](https://www.statcato.org) and open the program with the “Java Web Start” function. You do NOT need to install the program on the computer to use it.*

### **How to open Statcato with the “Java Web Start” function on Windows laptop or PC**

1. Go to <https://www.java.com/en/download/> and download the latest version of Java.
2. Go to the Control Panel of your computer and type in “Java”. Click on the Java Control Panel icon. Click on the “security” tab. Under the “Exception Site List” menu click on the “Edit Site List” button. Now click the “Add” button. Type in <https://www.statcato.org>. Then push OK and OK again.
3. Go to [www.statcato.org](https://www.statcato.org) and click on the “Use Statcato Now” button. Under the “Java Web Start” menu, click on “Launch Statcato”. If you get a notice that the Java version is out of data, push “Later”. If you get a notice that the application is blocked by Java security, repeat step 2.
4. Click on “Open With: Java (TM) Web Start Launcher (default)”. Click OK. You will get a couple notices saying that running this application is a security risk. Check the box that says “I accept the risk and want to run this application”. Now click the “Run” button. May have to repeat if the security risk screen comes open again.
5. A Statcato Updates screen will pop up. Do NOT click “download the latest version”. Just click “OK”. Statcato will now open on your computer.

*Note: Once you have done steps 1 and 2 on your laptop or home computer, you should not have to repeat them. But you will need to follow steps 3-5 every time you open Statcato.*

## **How to open Statcato with the “Java Web Start” function on MAC laptop or computer**

1. Go to <https://www.java.com/en/download/> and download the latest version of Java.
2. Click on the Apple icon on the upper left of screen. Click on “System Preferences”. Click on the Java icon to access the Java Control Panel. Click on the “security” tab. Under the “Exception Site List” menu click on the “Edit Site List” button. Now click the “Add” button. Type in <https://www.statcato.org>. Then push OK and OK again.
3. Go to [www.statcato.org](http://www.statcato.org) and click on the “Use Statcato Now” button. Under the “Java Web Start” menu, click on “Launch Statcato”. If you get a notice that the Java version is out of data, push “Later”. If you get a notice that the application is blocked by Java security, repeat step 2.
4. If you receive a message that the MAC computer will not open Statcato because it is not an identified developer, follow the following steps. Click on the Apple icon on the upper left of screen. Click on “System Preferences”. Click on “Security & Privacy”. At the bottom of the screen, you will see a message that “Statcato.jnlp was blocked from opening because it was not from an identified developer”. Click the “Open Anyway” button.
5. If you get a notice that the Java version is out of data, push “Later”. If you get a notice asking you to install a new update, click the “skip this version” button. A Statcato Updates screen will pop up. Do NOT click “download the latest version”. Just click “OK”. Statcato will now open on your computer.

*Note: Once you have done steps 1,2 and 4 on your laptop or home computer, you should not have to repeat them. But you will need to follow steps 3 and 5 every time you open Statcato.*
